WHO ARE THE ABAC AMBASSADORS?

The Ambassadors are a select group of students chosen for their enthusiasm, leadership ability, and communication skills who represent Abraham Baldwin in Tifton and across the state of Georgia. The Ambassadors' program involves approximately 14 students per year.

WHAT DO THE AMBASSADORS DO?

They assist at various campus functions such as Open Campus Day, Homecoming, Dollars for ABAC Scholars, Honors Day, Cordell Lectures, the President's Club Banquet, and many more. The Ambassadors also take one day in October to represent the college at the Sunbelt Expo at Spence Field near Moultrie.

WHAT IS REQUIRED OF ABAC AMBASSADORS?

Ambassadors must maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average. They must attend ABAC at least for the Fall 2008 and Spring 2009 terms. They must also spend at least 35 hours per semester with their Ambassador duties and attend a weekend retreat on September 5-7. **THIS RETREAT IS MANDATORY. If you cannot attend the retreat, do not apply.**

WHEN DO THE AMBASSADORS MEET?

The Ambassadors meet on a weekly basis on Mondays at 4 p.m. The meetings last from 30 to 45 minutes and are mandatory. Adjust your classes to make this meeting time.

IS THERE TRAINING FOR THE AMBASSADORS?

The Ambassadors will undergo an exciting weekend retreat at an off-campus location. They will learn how to speak in front of groups, public relations skills, and communication techniques.

HOW DO I JOIN THE AMBASSADORS?

An interview session will be held for prospective Ambassadors from 1-6 p.m. on Thursday, August 28 in the Evans Hall Conference Room. Prior to that time, applications should be completed on line or picked up from the Public Relations Office in Evans Hall. Completed applications are due in the Public Relations Office by **noon on Monday, August 25**, and a mandatory social will be held on **Wednesday, August 27 from 4:30-5:30 p.m.** in Evans Hall.
