

Academic Assistance

Sometimes just a little help can make a big difference in how successful a student is in a course. It is the goal of the Student Success Center (SSC) to promote academic success of students enrolled in all programs of study at the College.

Located on the ground floor of the Carlton Center, the SSC makes tutoring available free of charge to all currently enrolled ABAC students. Tutoring is available in math and writing from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Friday. The Center is open until midnight on Thursdays for quiet individual or group study sessions. Students should check with the Center each term for tutoring schedules. Some tutorials are one-on-one; others are organized as small groups. Review sessions are organized for students in classroom settings when appropriate.

The Writing Center is committed to serving the needs of student writers all across the curriculum. Students can get assistance with all aspects of writing, from developing a thesis to editing a draft. The Math Center provides tutoring for all levels of mathematics courses from developmental through calculus.

Tutors in the SSC are highly qualified, successful students who are selected not only for their knowledge but for their attitude and proven desire to help students succeed. Faculty members also volunteer in the Center.

The SSC hosts a series of workshops each term to foster the academic success of students. In past semesters these have included Learning Styles, Preview of College Algebra, Memory Techniques, Note Taking and Exam Preparation, Handling Oral Presentation Anxiety, and How to Study Science. Similar workshops are offered each term.
