DESCRIPTION: This course is designed to familiarize students with the opportunity to rationally exercise critical thinking and problem solving skills through experiential learning exercises. The student must have completed a majority of their major classes before being considered for this class. All decisions must be approved by departmental professor before implementation. Basic knowledge of greenhouse/nursery operations is required and should be further expanded. Also, participation in and completion of special activities will be required as identified.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES: Each student will develop individual outcomes for the course at the beginning of the term

OUTLINE: Determined by student after establishing expected outcomes of course.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

Projects: Complete projects relating to general operating procedures of a greenhouse/nursery as assigned by supervisor. Students are to perform a minimum of 6 hours per week on projects, which totals to 90 hours for the term.

Record Keeping: Maintain weekly records for all activities and submit to professor according to due dates given in course calendar.

Presentation: Prepare a final presentation utilizing PowerPoint software that covers all activities performed during the term. Minimum time of presentation is 15 minutes.

Final Report: Complete final report at the end of the term summarizing learning outcomes.

Extra Credit: Those individuals who join the Georgia Green Industry Association (GGIA) or Golf Course Superintendents Association of America (GCSAA) as a student member will be awarded points to their final average.
