

ID Quizzes: *No make-up quizzes will be given.* The lowest score of the 6 scheduled quizzes will be dropped. Each quiz will contain 20 plant specimens to be identified. Identification quizzes will be outdoors with full specimens or indoors with plant samples. Quizzes are cumulative. Each quiz is valued at 100 points. Each plant is assigned a value of 5 points. The points are allocated in the following manner:

For each misspelling, **one point** is lost. Please check spelling before handing in the quiz. Each word in the scientific and common name could be misspelled so be cautious.

The **generic name** of the scientific name is always capitalized (*Cornus*) and the **specific epithet** (*florida*) is lower case. The **variety** is written in lower case; however, the **cultivar name** is capitalized and enclosed in single quotation marks (shown above). For ease of presentation the **common name** is always capitalized (Flowering Dogwood).

Final ID Quiz: *No makeup ID final will be given.* Quiz will contain 40 plant specimens and scoring will be identical to the weekly plant identification quizzes.

Projects: Students will complete plant study sheets from lecture and other resources for a score of 100 points. Plant study sheets are available from the instructor for a nominal fee of \$5.00.

Photographs of 40 woody plants will be completed for a score of 200 points (see photo project assignment sheet).
