Transient Permission Request

Applicants applying for transient permission to another college or university must notify the Financial Aid Office of Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College after receiving transient permission from the Enrollment Services Office. The student is granted transient status for **one semester**. If they wish to continue as a transient student, they must submit a Financial Aid Transient Permission Request each semester for up to three consecutive semesters.

Please read and initial:

_____ A student receiving financial aid at their home institution will receive aid for the number of hours enrolled at the host institution upon receipt of a completed Consortium Agreement provided by that host institution.

_____ The student should be **prepared to pay** for any and/or all expenses at the host institution related to their attendance, including tuition, fees, books, etc. Federal funds will not be available at the time of enrollment and registration.

_____ Financial aid checks will be sent to the host institution's financial aid office to be given to the student upon verification of number of hours attending and that the student remains in good standing.

_____ The student should be aware that not all institutions enter into a Consortium Agreement for transient study. It is the student's responsibility to verify that the host institution will enter into a Consortium Agreement prior to attending.
