Over 3,300 students from 17 states, 11 countries, and 152 Georgia counties take classes every day on a beautiful 421-acre ABAC campus nestled in the heart of south Georgia in Tifton.

Athletics and Intramural Sports

- Six intercollegiate sports: men's baseball, golf, and tennis; women's soccer, softball, and tennis. Intramural sports include flag football (15 teams; two competed in 2009 state tournament), soccer (5 teams), men's and women's basketball (11 teams), coed softball (23 teams), and bowling. The Recreational Sports Office also sponsors golf and tennis tournaments.
- Recreational facilities include 18-hole golf course, Lake Baldwin, gymnasium, weight room/fitness center, intramural soccer and softball fields, walking track, and olympic sized swimming pool.

Facilities

- Recognized student clubs and organizations have access to campus facilities for meetings and special events.
- On-Campus facilities range from small classroom or study areas to Howard Auditorium, which seats 350.
- Nearby conference facilities at the State Museum of Agriculture (operated by ABAC) and UGA Tifton Campus are available to student groups for a fee.
