REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE INTO NURSING

1. Complete Application for Nursing by required deadline
2. Successfully Complete All Pre-Requisites With a C or Greater. AND Achieve a GPA of 2.50 on these Core Courses. GPA Calculation – Only Core Courses Required for The Associate Degree Nursing Program Will Be Used. GRADES ACHIEVED IN ALL ATTEMPTS WILL BE USED. Science Courses and Corresponding Labs Can Only Be Repeated ONE TIME ONLY.
3. If a student has 2 failures from another nursing program (s), the student will not be eligible for ABAC's nursing program.
4. Grades of "D", "F", and/or "WF" in core courses applicable to the nursing program that are older than 10 years will not be calculated in the admission GPA.
