**REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE INTO NURSING**

1. Complete Application for Nursing by required deadline.
2. Successfully Complete All Core Courses With a C or Greater. **AND** Achieve a GPA of 2.50 on these Core Courses.  
GRADES ACHIEVED IN ALL ATTEMPTS WILL BE USED.
3. Hold A Current Licensure as a Practical Nurse, Paramedic, Surgical Technician, or Respiratory Therapist in the State of Georgia.
4. If a student has 2 failures from another nursing program (s) that occurred after receiving the above licensure, the student will not be eligible for ABAC's nursing program.
5. Purchase Transition Course Review Modules and successfully complete a comprehensive examination and a pharmacology validation examination.
