

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Early Childhood Education

**1. *Are any of the courses offered online or in the evening?***

Only the MATH courses are offered online. All other education courses are held on the ABAC campus in a combination of day, evening, and online. They are typically scheduled two days per week.

**2. *How long will it take to complete the degree?***

The time it takes to complete the degree is two years (5 semesters, including Summer) once you have completed your Associates degree. All ECE students are required to take the full load of prescribed courses each semester.

**3. *Can I start taking GSW courses before I finish my ABAC Associates degree?***

GSW's School of Education will not enroll students that have not completed their Associate of Science in Early Childhood Education. Completing your ABAC Associates degree satisfies all core requirements at GSW, therefore making the transition a seamless process.

**4. *How often will I have to travel to GSW's campus in Americus?***

Most students will never need to set foot on the GSW campus in Americus until their graduation day (if they choose to participate). All of ABAC's amenities are offered to GSW students enrolled in the program, including access to the computer labs, library, bookstore, health services, dining hall, and even the residence halls.

**5. *I have an Associates degree in something other than Early Childhood Education. Can I still enroll in the GSW program?***

Students that have not taken all of the required courses for an Associate of Science in Early Childhood Education must do so before being accepted to the GSW School of Education.

**6. *I have not taken or passed all three parts of the GACE I. Can I still be accepted?***

The GSW School of Education will not admit students into the ECE program that have not taken and passed all three parts of the GACE I.
