Donaldson Award

The George P. Donaldson Award recognizes the most outstanding member of the graduating class. Named in honor of a former ABAC President, Dr. George P. (Pete) Donaldson, the award is presented by the ABAC Alumni Association at the December and May graduation ceremonies.

Who's Who at ABAC

Those named to Who's Who at ABAC are nominated for their contributions to campus life while enrolled. Inclusion in this select group ranks as the highest non-academic honor a student may receive.

The honorees, both men and women, are chosen from among the nominees selected by a student-faculty committee. Three freshmen and two faculty or staff make up the selection committee. The committee is appointed by the SGA President and the Dean of Students. To be eligible for nomination, a student must have completed at least 30 semester hours at ABAC with a 3.0 or better cumulative Regents' GPA. Learning Support hours are not included in the 30 hours.

Mr. and Ms. Baldwin are selected from among the list of Who's Who at ABAC during the SGA election held in the spring. The male and female receiving the most votes are named Mr. and Ms. Baldwin in recognition of their extraordinary service and leadership.
