

Student Support Services

ABAC is among the growing number of over 700 colleges and universities nationwide that have Student Support Services (SSS) programs on their campus. If you are a first generation college student, low income, or have a learning disability, the Student Support Services program is the place that will assist, advise and provide that needed academic support. Student Support Services offices are located on the first floor of the Carlton Center.

The Trio Student Support Services Program is a federally funded program designed to increase college retention and graduation rates for eligible students; to increase the transfer rates of eligible students; and to foster an institutional climate supportive of the success of low-income and first generation college students and individuals with disabilities. SSS provides scheduled one-on-one peer tutoring, group tutoring, supplemental instruction, transfer assistance, career and academic advising and exposure to cultural events around the state. The Program publishes a newsletter, the *ADVOCATE*, each semester outlining many workshop opportunities for students that will help them progress at ABAC.
