Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by **Josh Nicholson, Vice President**.

Motion to accept minutes: **Senator Sara Ervin**, seconded by **Senator Tom Lanier**.

**Jessica Gandy, Chief Justice of Judicial Court**, inducted new senators.

**Paula Rogers, Treasurer**, stated that the budget stands at \$13,922.87

**Tahj Brown, Chief Justice of Traffic Court**, stated that there was 1 name on the docket, a no show.

**Jessica Gandy, Chief Justice of Judicial Court**, stated that Judicial Court was not held this week.

**Carl Langford Jr., Club Coordinator**, stated that

- Each senator should pick up two forms before leaving: a Halloween Carnival Activity Request form (if club was not present at last week's meeting; this form has also been emailed to all club advisors) and a Stallion Day club attendance form; both due by October 14<sup>th</sup>.
- Clubs need to fill out event request forms for all campus-wide events, fundraisers, or community service projects prior to the event. If a flyer is being used for promotion it must be approved by SGA prior to being posted.
- If the new stallion logo is to be used on promotional materials (shirts, cups, etc.) it needs to be approved by Mike Chason or Ashley Williamson prior to printing.
- The Chartering Committee will meet after the SGA meeting.

Committee Reports as follows:

- **Academic Affairs, Neal Torley** – Members should see the committee chair to verify that all contact information is correct. The committee is exploring possibilities for introducing new and varied courses.
- **Student Affairs, Tanner Newhouse** – Members should see the committee chair to receive information for future meetings.
- **External Affairs, Hannah Weathersby** – Members should check their email for updated information and volunteers are needed for Relay for Life.

In the president's report, **Sara Ervin, President Pro-Tempore**, made comments and provided information for the following:

- Stallion Day is going to be held October 24<sup>th</sup>. Ashley Williamson needs help directing traffic for prospective students and parents. Ten to twelve volunteers are needed and a foam finger will be supplied. Complete information will be given at a meeting that morning in Evans Hall at 7:00 a.m.
- The SGA meeting seating chart will not change from this day forward.
- Halloween Carnival funds will be reimbursed to the clubs through use of foundation accounts. This is the official recommendation of the SGA executive board.
