The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by **Stephen Aaron, Vice President**.

Senator Megan Green moved to amend the October 13, 2010 minutes by striking \$7,077.62 and adding \$6,997.62 and the motion was seconded by **Senator Chris Earls**. The amendment passed by majority vote. The motion to accept the minutes was then made by **Senator Chris Earls** and seconded by **Senator Andrew Cruz**. The motion passed by majority vote.

Michael Arena, Treasurer, announced that the budget currently stands at \$6,997.62.

Cody Morris, Chief Justice of Judicial Court, announced there was no court held this week and inducted two new senators, **Ronald Few** and **Frank Dola**.

Eric Pansen, Chief Justice of Traffic Court, announced that there were 3 names on the docket this week. 2 tickets were granted and 1 was denied.

Committee reports were as follows:

- **Academic Affairs: Ashley Morris** announced there was no business to report.
- **Student Affairs: Ashley Morris** announced which clubs were confirmed to participate in the Fall Carnival to be held October 28th.
- **External Affairs: Ashley Morris** announced there was no business to report this week.

In the President's Report, **Jazmin Thomas, President**, provided information on the following:

- Campout for the Homeless to be held November 12th at Lakeside Lawn. Set up is at 5pm and will last until 7am on November 13th.
- The outcome of the Tobacco Free Campus Poll and is as follows: 53% voted in favor for a Tobacco Free Campus, 43% voted against it, and 4% voted no preference.
- If your club needs extension cords for the Fall Carnival bring it with you. The corn maze will be kid friendly from 6:30pm until 8:30pm. The corn maze will then become haunted until 10pm. If you want to help with the corn maze or with cotton candy see Jazmin.
- ABAC's Got Talent is November 19th, if you know of any faculty or staff member who will participate ask them and let SGA know.

Old Business was as follows:

- The motion to take from the table for SGA to have a canned food drive was made by **Senator Megan Green** and seconded by **Senator Chris Earls**. The motion passed by majority vote. **Senator Marcus Grant** amended the main motion by adding November 1st until the end of November. The amendment was seconded by **Senator Chris Earls** and the amendment passed by majority vote. Previous question was moved by **Senator Ronald Few** and seconded by **Senator Chris Earls**. Previous question was passed by a two-thirds vote of 20-0. The main motion failed by majority vote.
