The meeting was called to order at 6:01pm by **Stephen Aaron, Vice President**.

The motion to accept the minutes from November 10, 2010 was made by **Senator Chris Earls** and seconded by **Senator Andrew Cruz**. The motion passed by majority vote.

Michael Arena, Treasurer, announced that the budget currently stands at \$6,851.12.

Cody Morris, Chief Justice of Judicial Court, announced there was one name on the docket this week and they were sanctioned accordingly.

Eric Pansen, Chief Justice of Traffic Court, announced court was not held this week.

Committee reports were as follows:

- **Academic Affairs: Tanner Newhouse** announced Friday, November 12th, a curriculum committee meeting was held and new classes were in the works for ABAC. Tanner will have info on each of these classes in the Spring Semester.
- **Student Affairs: Kevin Vantrees** introduced two proposals to the senate for approval. The outcomes of each are as follows:
 1. We the Student Affairs Committee propose that the Police Academy at Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College, during their morning personal fitness running, be re-routed due to the disturbance of quiet hour for students. The re-routing course has been proposed by Senator Andrew Cruz; therefore, making it suitable for the students to have the quiet hours that they need for the day. The motion passed by majority vote.
 2. We the Student Affairs Committee propose that the lights at ABAC Place near the volleyball court be relocated to a feasible location. Many of the residents have complained that the lights are too bright, and it shines through their windows causing a disturbance during quiet hours. Also, many of the student volleyball players feel that the lights are too bright at the current location. We feel that if the lights were relocated, the relocation will benefit both the housing and student volleyball players. The motion passed by majority vote.
- **External Affairs: Ashley Morris** announced there was no business to report this week.

In the President's Report, **Jazmin Thomas, President**, provided information on the following:

- Campout for the Homeless was a great success. SGA was able to donate \$280 to Atlanta Children's Shelter.
