The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by **Stephen Aaron, Vice President**.

The motion to accept the minutes from February 9, 2011 was made by **Senator Kristen Ray** and seconded by **Senator Samuel Smith**. The motion passed by majority vote.

Michael Arena, Treasurer, announced that the budget currently stands at \$5,680.92.

Cody Morris, Chief Justice of Judicial Court, announced that court was not held this week

Eric Pansen, Chief Justice of Traffic Court, announced there were two names on the docket, one appeal was denied and the other was reduced.

Committee reports were as follows:

- **Academic Affairs: Tanner Newhouse** announced there was no business to report this week.
- **Student Affairs: Kevin Vantrees** introduced one new proposal to the senator for approval:
 - We, the student affairs committee, propose that there be a RedBox machine on campus. To better the student life, we believe that adding a RedBox machine on campus will be beneficial to the student body. Seeing how the closest RedBox machine is located at Wal-Mart, putting a RedBox machine will be more convenient for students. This machine will be located at Town Hall, and will be monitored by the ABAC Place Community Assistants that are on duty. Also, the machine will be available from when the time Town Hall opens until midnight when the Community Assistants close Town Hall. The motion passed by majority vote.
- **External Affairs: Ashley Morris** reminded the senate that the Celebrate ABAC Rodeo is fast approaching and each club should be organizing their events.

- SGA is planning to host a Student vs. Faculty basketball game March 29, 2011 in Gressette Gym at 7pm. Signups to participate will be first come first serve. Location of the signup sheet will be posted at a later date. Entrance to watch the game will be \$0.50 and snacks will be sold during the event.
