The meeting was called to order at 6:02pm by **Stephen Aaron, Vice President**.

The motion to accept the minutes from April 21, 2010 and August 25, 2010 was made by **Senator Andrew Cruz** and seconded by **Senator Chris Earls**. The motion passed by majority vote.

Michael Arena, Treasurer, announced that the budget currently stands at \$13,625.62.
