The meeting was called to order at 6:02pm by **Ashley Morris, Vice President**.

The motion to accept the minutes from September 28, 2011 was made by **Senator Ronald Few** and seconded by **Senator Bradley Harris**. The motion passed by majority vote.

Camille Odom, Treasurer, announced that the budget currently stands at \$11,281.02.

Tremaine Dupree, Chief Justice of Judicial Court, announced court was not held this week.

Heather Center, Chief Justice of Traffic Court, announced there were 7 names on the docket this week. 1 case was appealed, 6 were denied.

Committee reports were as follows:

- **Academic Affairs: Cody Morris** announced there was nothing to report this week.
- **Student Affairs: Pete Dola** introduced the following proposal to the senate for approval:
 1. We, the student affairs committee, propose that a gold card machine be installed in the middle floor laundry room in every building.
