**Campaign Guidelines**

All candidates must adhere to the rules and regulations described below

1. All posted materials must be approved by the Office of Student Life and Housing. Following administrator approval, your materials will be stamped with an official college approval stamp. Once your materials have been approved and stamped, you may copy and post them.
2. No posted materials are permitted on the walls, furniture, lampposts or doors on campus. Only on bulletin boards for general use.
3. Candidates are prohibited from using ANY School (SGA/CAB/Any Other Office) materials for campaign purposes (markers, paper, copier, computer, etc.) You must supply your own material.
4. Each candidate may request up to \$50 in campaign funding. Strict rules apply. You have to get a receipt from the store with only campaign materials on it; cannot be mixed with other purchases. See Ms. Van McGriff in the Office the Vice President for Student Affairs.
5. Postings in any residence halls **MUST** be on the bulletin boards and **NOT ON ANY GLASS WINDOWS or DOORS!** For all postings on walls please use **MASKING TAPE ONLY**, no duct tape or scotch tape.
6. Sheets, banners and tapestries are **NOT** allowed. Postings larger than an average size poster board are not allowed.
7. Sidewalk chalk is not allowed on pavers (brick sidewalks), on buildings, or on covered porch areas.
8. Do on place flyers on cars.
9. Mass e-mails for your campaign are **NOT** allowed.
10. All posted materials must be removed on the day after the election.
11. Candidates are not allowed to aggressively campaign on the day of the elections. Due to the fact the elections are online, candidates are on the honor system and expected to act ethically on Election Day. During the voting period, candidates may not actively campaign within 20 feet of any visible computer.
12. Any candidate found responsible for tampering with another candidate's campaign materials will be disqualified from the election. .
13. Any candidate found in violation of these rules and regulations is subject to disqualification from the election.
