Oahu - Kauai

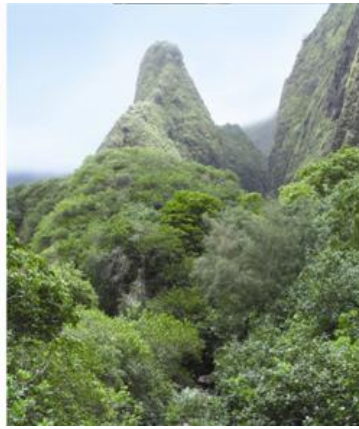
