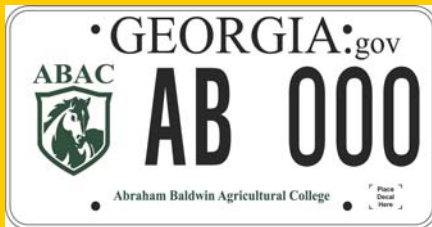
### Summer Term Registration Thursday

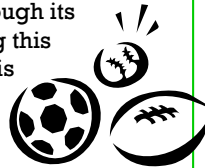
### Summer Kids College Classes In Full Swing
