State Museum of Ag Open This Saturday

The State Museum of Agriculture and Historic Village at Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College will be open on July 3 from 9 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Free ice cold watermelon will be available in honor of Independence Day. The Tifton Exchange Club will also be giving out free American flags. Admission is \$7 for adults and \$4 for children.

The museum first opened on July 4, 1976. In addition to the museum and numerous historic buildings, the 95-acre site includes a traditional 1870s farm community and an 1890s progressive farmstead. Features include a saw-mill, blacksmith shop, schoolhouse, feed and seed store, print shop, grist mill, and turpentine still. The steam train will also be running during the day.
