What You Can Do In

25 Live

- Create an event
- ► Find out what's happening on selected dates for locations, resources, or organizations
- Search for events, locations, resources, or organizations
- Print, save, or email a wide variety of reports for events, locations, resources, and organizations
- ▶ Publish events to online calendars created and administered via 25live Publisher



Important glossary of terms

- ► Event: Any activity being planned and tracked in 25live. The activity does not necessarily have to have a space attached to it. For example, calendar announcements. An event in 25live can only have one start and end time.
- **Event Wizard** The event creation form.
- ▶ Head Count: The expected number of people attending the event.
- Organization: The group sponsoring the event.
- Resource: Anything other than a location that's required for an event, such as equipment, catering, personnel, tables, chairs, audio visual equipment, etc.
- Space: The term used to describe a location in 25live.
- ▶ Location: A room or other facility (such as a pool or playing field) where events may occur.







The 25Live Home tab provides three working views of 25Live for quick access to the information formats you need.




Image: You have multiple view choices available to you on the 25Live Home tab.



Dashboard is for quick access to a variety of 25live information and functionality

Calendar provides easy access to event taking place on a date(you specify)

Availability displays a daily view of locations on a single date
