Pallet Design Rules



Rules:

- Pallets will be available at 6:00pm on Monday, April 2.
- Clubs will be given a designated number of pallets.
- No additional pallets or wood may be used.
- Additional materials such as paint, fabric, props, etc. are acceptable.
- Pallets will be judged at 9:00am on Thursday, April 5.
- Scores will be based upon condition of structure at this time.



Criteria:

The judges will base their decision on the following guidelines. The highest possible score is 100.

A. HOMECOMING THEME: 0-40 points Does the pallet adequately convey the homecoming theme of *ABAC Suits You*? It is acceptable but not necessary for the design to look like cards. Any design that demonstrates how ABAC "suits" its students is welcomed.

B. CRAFTSMANSHIP: 0-30 points. The craftsmanship score will depend on neatness, solid construction, detail, and visual appeal. Does the pallet appear to be stable and will it last throughout the week?

C. CREATIVITY/ORIGINALITY: 0-30 points. Did the club incorporate a unique idea with creative implementation? Did the club use different and unexpected materials (think outside the paint can)? A creative design doesn't necessarily need to be elaborate, but it should be well thought-out and make sense to an observer.
