

Due to threats of inclement weather from Hurricane Irma, Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College announces the following:

1. ABAC's Tifton Campus, ABAC's Georgia Museum of Agriculture, ABAC's Forest Lakes Golf Course and ABAC on the Square (Moultrie) will cease normal business operations at 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 9, 2017. All ABAC facilities will reopen for business at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 13, 2017. All events scheduled during the period of closure have been cancelled.
2. All classes for ABAC students have been cancelled for Monday, September 11 and Tuesday, September 12, 2017. Classes will resume on Wednesday, September 13, 2017, unless otherwise notified.
3. ABAC residence halls and dining operations will remain open for normal business hours.
4. ABAC Police, residence life, dining personnel, and physical plant personnel will remain on duty during the closure.
5. Gressette Gym and Thrash Wellness Center will be used for evacuation and emergency preparedness beginning at 6 p.m. on Friday, September 8, 2017. Therefore, these facilities will not be available for student or employee use until further notice.

The ABAC Police Department will continue to monitor the situation. Any necessary safety-related information will be sent directly to students, faculty, and staff through the Campus Alert System via text message, voice call, and email.
