| Russell A. Acree Nursing Scholarship Fund | Freshman nursing students with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher are eligible for this scholarship. |
| Sue M. And James Lee Adams Jr. Scholarship Endowment | Demonstrated financial need. In awarding such scholarships, first preference shall be given to qualified undergraduate students who meet any of the following criteria, in order of the following preference: 1) graduated from Westwood Schools (Camilla Schools, Inc.) in Camilla, Mitchell County, Georgia; 2) resident of Mitchell County, Georgia; or, 3) resident of any of the other following Southwest Georgia counties: Baker, Dougherty, Worth, Colquitt, Thomas, Grady, Decatur, Miller, Brooks, and Seminole. |
| ABAC Alpha Gamma Rho (AGR) Endowment | Established to provide support for students actively involved in Alpha Gamma Rho (AGR) at ABAC including, but not limited to, awards, other professionally related experiences such as attendance at meetings/conventions, and scholarships. The student must also have a 3.0 or higher GPA. |
| SANR Alumni Scholarship Fund | The ABAC Ag Alumni Scholarship is awarded to students with recommendations from faculty in the School of Agriculture and Natural Resources, this scholarship gives preference to leaders in FFA, FCCLA and 4-H. |
| Jo Anne Anderson Endowed Nursing Scholarship | Established by Dr. Greg Anderson and Ms. Janie Anderson, this scholarship is awarded to an ABAC student majoring in nursing in either the associate degree or bachelor's degree program. The recipient must demonstrate financial need. |
