

One Button Studio (OBS)

What is the OBS

- OBS is an easy-to-use professional recording studio available in the Baldwin Library (Carlton Center 2nd floor) next to the library computer lab.

How to Access

- OBS is simple to use.
 - To get started insert a USB 3.0 flash drive in the hub labeled “Insert USB drive here.”
 - Turn on the in-use switch, so you are not disturbed while recording
 - Tap the red button to start recording.
 - Tap the red button again to stop the recording
- If you would like to use touch display in your recording, use the keyboard and mouse provided on the desk to sign in using your ABAC Username and password.
- Use the provided pen to annotate slides in PowerPoint or open Microsoft whiteboard.

Features

- OBS can be used to record a class presentation, practice for an interview or to improve public speaking skills.
- “In Use” light above the door lets you know when the room is available.
- OBS features professional lighting and microphone for professional recordings.
