How to Apply for HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarships

HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarships

Two Options:

1. Complete the GSFAPP at gafutures.org (valid for 10 years),
or
2. Submit a FAFSA every year

Thunder & Lightning say: Complete a GSFAPP so you always have a HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarship application on file.



Selective Service

To receive HOPE/ Zell Miller Scholarships, a student must be in compliance with Georgia state law requirements of having registered with the United States Selective Service System.



Tips for Success:

- You can register up to 30 days prior to your 18th birthday
- Make sure you use your legal name, SSN and date of birth

- Must maintain a 3.0 “College” HOPE GPA

What will HOPE Scholarship Pay (100% of Prior Year Tuition)?

- For the 2025-26 academic year the HOPE per credit hour amount at ABAC is \$109.00 with a maximum payment of \$1,635.



Zell Miller Scholarship

High School Academic Eligibility

- 3.7 “High School” Zell GPA AND
- 4 Rigorous Courses While in High School AND
- Test Score Component (1200 SAT Critical Reading/Math or 26 ACT)
 - – Standard Policy > single test administration by High School Graduation
 - OR
- Be Valedictorian or Salutatorian

College Academic Eligibility

- Must maintain a 3.3 “College” HOPE GPA

What will Zell Miller Scholarship Pay (100% of Current Year Tuition)?

- For the 2025-26 academic year the Zell Miller Scholarship per credit hour amount at ABAC is \$109.00 with a maximum payment of \$1,635.



ABAC GPA vs HOPE GPA

ABAC GPA includes transferable courses (including Dual Enrollment).

HOPE GPA does not include Dual Enrollment courses

APPROVED STEM courses (as of Fall 2017) receive added weight for HOPE/Zell GPA calculation purposes

- ONLY applies to grades of B,C,D
- Added weight = 0.5
- Approved STEM course list is available on <https://www.gafutures.org/>

How To Track Your HOPE Academic Eligibility

Georgia's HOPE Programs are for those students who demonstrate academic achievement, not only in high school but throughout their time in college.

Beginning in high school, Georgia students are able to track their [My High School HOPE GPA](#) through their GAfutures account to know if they are on track to earn the [HOPE](#) and [Zell Miller Scholarship](#).

Now, with the [My College HOPE Profile](#), students who have earned the [HOPE](#) or [Zell Miller Scholarship](#), as well as the [HOPE](#) or [Zell Miller Grant](#), can track their academic eligibility while attending a HOPE-eligible Georgia college or university.

Note: GAfutures accounts require the student's Social Security number and date of birth in order to provide the student's secure academic data.

Annual Loan Limits

Grade Level	Dependent Student	Independent Student
Freshman (less than 30 hours)	\$5,500 (up to \$3,500 can be subsidized)	\$9,500 (up to \$3,500 can be subsidized)
Sophomore (30-59 hours)	\$6,500 (up to \$4,500 can be subsidized)	\$10,500 (up to \$4,500 can be subsidized)
Junior/Senior (60 or more hours)	\$7,500 (up to \$5,500 can be subsidized)	\$12,500 (up to \$5,500 can be subsidized)

Who can receive Direct Subsidized Loans?

Direct Subsidized Loans are available to students who demonstrate financial need.

Who will pay the interest?

- The U.S. Department of Education pays the interest on a Direct Subsidized Loan
- while you're in school at least half-time,
- for the first six months after you leave school (referred to as a grace period), and
- during a period of deferment (a postponement of loan payments).



Who can receive Direct Unsubsidized Loans?

Direct Unsubsidized Loans are available to all students who successfully file a FAFSA.

Who will pay the interest?

- You are responsible for paying the interest on a Direct Unsubsidized Loan during all periods.

Good to know

- If you choose not to pay the interest while you are in school and during grace periods and deferment or forbearance periods, your interest will accrue (accumulate) and be capitalized (that is, your interest will be added to the principal amount of your loan).



Federal Direct Loan Origination Fees

The Origination Fee is the amount a borrower is required to pay the U.S. Department of Education to help defray the cost of a Federal Direct Loan.

Loan Type	Origination Fee
Subsidized & Unsubsidized Loans	1.057%
Parent PLUS Loans	4.228%

Example: Student accepts \$5500 in the Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan for the 2025-2026 academic year.

This amount is split equally over Fall 2025 & Spring 2026 semesters.
(\$2750 Fall / \$2750 Spring)

Once the loan origination fee has been deducted, the net amount of \$2721 will apply toward the student's account balance in eStallion.

A student must have a FAFSA on file for a parent to be able to obtain a Parent PLUS Loan.

To apply for the Parent PLUS Loan, the parent must log into studentaid.gov with the **parent's FSAID** and apply for a Parent PLUS Loan.

When completing the Parent PLUS Loan application, the parent may select they want:

- the maximum
- a specific amount
- don't know what amount to borrow

The interest rate for Parent PLUS Loans disbursed during the 2025-26 academic year is 8.94%.

If your financial situation has changed since the 2023 tax return was filed, an SAI adjustment may be permitted.

Please email finaid@abac.edu to initiate a review to determine what documentation would be required for an appeal.

Examples of situations that may qualify for adjustment:

- Loss or change of employment
- Death of a parent or spouse

Appeals should be submitted by July 15, 2025, to allow for processing prior to the fee payment deadline.

- Roster Verification
- Withdrawal from some courses
- Withdrawal from all courses
 - Return to Title IV
- Unofficial withdrawals
 - Received F's in all courses
- Course Program of Study
 - Coming Summer 2026



Satisfactory Academic Progress

- Required for state and federal aid as well as most institutional aid
- All coursework counts in the calculation
- Three measures of progress:
 - GPA – 2.0 cumulative GPA is required at the end of every semester.
 - Pace – must be completing 66.67% of the courses attempted
 - 150% limit – must complete program of study prior to reaching 150% of the published length of the program



Meal Plan Options

- All housing residents are required to participate in a meal plan.
- Freshmen student options (students completing less than 30 credit hours):
 - 12-Meal Plan = \$1,950 per semester and includes \$250 dining dollars
 - Unlimited Meal Plan = \$1,950 per semester and includes \$85 dining dollars
- Upperclassmen student options
 - 100 Block Meal Plan = \$1,130 per semester including \$125 dining dollars (students completing more than 30 credit hours):
 - \$150 Dining Dollar Only Plan (students completing 60 credit hours and are enrolled in a four-year Baccalaureate degree program)
- Commuter Plans
 - 60 Block Meal Plan = \$615 per semester
 - 25 Block Meal Plan = \$260 per semester


