Tuition Assistance (TA) is a Department of Defense (DoD) program. VA does not administer TA. TA rules vary by branch of service and can even vary between units depending on whether a unit is active, reserve or National Guard. If a student receives education benefits from VA and receives TA benefits from the military, duplication of benefits may be an issue. The issues might involve VA regulations, DoD regulations, or both since VA and DoD both have regulations regarding receiving VA benefit and TA at the same time. It is the student's responsibility to ensure there isn't a duplication of benefits.
